

CONTINUED WORK SESSION OF THE FARMVILLE TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON AUGUST 12, 2014

At the continued work session meeting of the Farmville Town Council held on Tuesday, August 12, 2014 at 12:00 pm, in the Conference Room of the Town Manager's Office located at 116 North Main Street, Farmville, Virginia, there present were Mayor D.E. Whitus, presiding and Council members P.W. Butler, D.L. Hunter, S.B. Thompson, T.M. Pairet, A.D. Reid, J.J. Davis, and G.C. Cole.

Staff present was Town Manager, Gerald Spates and Town Clerk, Lisa Hricko.

Mayor Whitus called the meeting to order at 12:20 pm and welcomed guests: Longwood University President, W. Taylor Reveley IV and his Chief of Staff, Justine Pope.

President Reveley addressed Council. He spoke of his strong family ties to the community and to Longwood University. He said the University will soon begin working on its Master Plan and wish to include input from the Town. It is the University's desire to create a campus that will encourage student foot traffic to the downtown area.

President Reveley addressed the Town/University streets and parking issue. He said it is the University's desire to purchase the Town streets surrounding Longwood; for planning purposes, initially mentioned were Madison and Redford. The Town Manager stressed the importance of protecting the Town's water and sewer lines and being able to provide emergency services within the campus. Discussions ensued. Conversations concluded with President Reveley and Council agreeing to table the issue of selling the streets for the present time and that consideration is given to entering into a Revenue Sharing Agreement for a portion of the monies the University collects for parking on Town streets within the campus.

There being no other business, the meeting adjourned.
