

**SPECIAL CALL COUNCIL MEETING OF THE FARMVILLE TOWN COUNCIL**  
**HELD ON OCTOBER 9, 2015**

At the special call Council meeting of the Farmville Town Council held on Friday, October 9, 2015 at 10:00 am, in the Town Manager's Conference Room located at 116 North Main Street, Farmville, Virginia, there present were Mayor D.E. Whitus, presiding and Council members D.E. Dwyer, D.L. Hunter, S.B. Thompson, T.M. Pairet, A.D. Reid, and G.C. Cole. Council member J.J. Davis was absent.

Staff present was Town Manager, Gerald Spates; Chief of Police, Curtis Davis; Police Captain, Andy Ellington; Director of Public Works, Robin Atkins and Town Clerk, Lisa Hricko.

Mayor Whitus called the meeting to order and Mr. Spates read the Special Meeting Notice stating the purpose of the special meeting was to create a budget for the upcoming Vice-Presidential Debate, scheduled for October 4, 2016 at Longwood University.

Mayor Whitus stated a meeting with the Governor's staff and members of his finance committee has been scheduled for Wednesday, October 14. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss possible state funding for the upcoming debate.

Council members and town staff discussed potential Town needs for the event, included were additional staffing, funding for overtime, signage, Town beautification projects, banners, barricades, cones, additional street paving, equipment, etc.

Mayor Whitus, Vice Mayor Reid and Council members Hunter and Davis along with the Town Manager agreed to meet with the Governor's staff and present the Town's request.

There being no other business, the meeting adjourned at 10:34 am.
