
Get to Know Smoke Alarms

1. If there is a fire in your home, there will be smoke. A smoke alarm will let you know there is a fire in your home.
2. You need a smoke alarm in each bedroom. You also need one outside each sleeping area.
3. You need a smoke alarm on each level of your home.
4. Push the test button at least once a month to make sure it is working.
5. Some alarms need a new battery once a year. Replace smoke alarms every ten years.
6. If the smoke alarm sounds, get outside of the home.
7. Then call the fire department. Dial 9-1-1.
