Police Investigate Shooting

FARMVILLE, VA - At approximately 12:48 a.m. on June 24, 2018 Farmville Police responded to a call of shots fired in the parking lot of a local business located in the 2000 block of South Main Street. Within minutes, Officers arrived on scene and discovered a male subject had been shot in the abdomen and was being transported by personal vehicle to the hospital. The victim was later transported to VCU/MCV hospital in Richmond, VA for treatment.

Police remained on scene for approximately 3 hours processing the scene for evidence and interviewing multiple witnesses. Witnesses stated that a group of individuals were arguing in the parking lot with the victim when one of the suspects displayed a handgun and shot the victim. Criminal charges are pending as detectives continue to identify and interview witnesses and gather additional evidence.
