The following is an excerpt from Section 14-11 of the Code of the Town of Farmville that applies to persons or business collecting tax on food/lodging.

“Each person or business subject to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article V, Section 25-101 and 25-113, inclusive of this Code, shall, upon making a person responsible for collecting and paying the tax imposed and filing and maintaining all records under Chapter 25, Article V of this Code. Said person shall also sign the application, under oath, and shall specifically agree to accept all criminal and civil liability for a failure to comply to Chapter 25, Article V of this Code shall have its license issued under this section automatically suspended by the treasurer. Prior to suspension, the treasurer shall give the responsible person written notification whither by personal delivery or certified mail of noncompliance with Chapter 25, Article V. The responsible person shall then have thirty (30) days to comply with Chapter 25, Article V and failure to completely comply thereafter will result in automatic termination of the license issued hereunder. The business and responsible person shall then be notified of the termination of said license and may then be subjected to penalties prescribed in Section 14-26 if business is continued.

This section shall not apply to tax on telephone service, business firms or corporations that operate at more than one (1) location within the town, or apartment complexes and residential dwellings.”
